regarding Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) issued by the University Grants Commission has informed that both are path breaking initiatives which can transform the quality of Higher Education in ourcountry. The first document provides a framework for Certification of Skills and for provision of credits for such Skill and Theory to acquire formal University and Board Certification. The second document provides for Semesterization of Curricula in the Universities, Choices of Courses for Students and Standardisation of the Examination and Credit System to allow for mobility.

- The Ministry of Human Resource Development gives vary high priority to adaption of the Credit System for Skills and Education and of the Choice Based Credit System by State Universities and other Institutions. The credit framework, using the NSQF and National Occupational standards, is an exercise in recognising Skills and Education as part of an Integrated Learning System. It is an effort to bridge the gap between Certificate and Diploma level and between Diploma and Degree levels by allowing for mobility from one to the other. It also provides an opportunity to the Graduates of Vocational Education to further pursue Post Graduate learning. The best of the Universities across the world follow the Choice Based Credit System which facilitates diversity of opportunities for the students and also encourages their employability. The Skills and Education Credit System is path breaking in permitting a formal Certification through the University System of Vocational Skills. The adoption of the Choice Based Credit System will permit students doing General Graduate Programmes to take credits in Semesters for Skiii Based Programmes as well, if they so desire. This will greatly facilitate their employability. The success of Make in India, Digital India, Skill India ali depend on our ability to improve outcomes for the Higher Education System.
 - 3. Both the Systems need to be adopted soon. This will require iot of work on semesterization of Curriculum, Standardization of Examinations and Restructuring of Syllabi and in the form of modules, identification of Core Courses, Elective Courses and Foundation Courses.

- 7. The Secretary, Telangana State Council of Higher Education in the reference 11th cited, has informed that, with reference to the Public Notice issued by the UGC dt. 10.04.2015 seeking views and feedback from stakeholders on CBCS Model Curriculum and letter dt. 17.04.2015 from the State Government, a Meeting of the Deans of Faculties of all the State Universities and representative from Commissioner Collegiate Education and Members of the State Level Committee on CBCS was conducted on 24.04.2015 at Telangana State Council of Higher Education. The Meeting was chaired by the Prof. T. Papi Reddy, Chairman, Telangana State Council of Higher Education (TSCHE) and Co-chaired by Prof. S. Mallesh, Vice-Chairman, TSCHE. The Chairman after briefing the objectives of the meeting, requested the members to actively participate in the deliberations and express their views and opinions on CBCS for its implementation.
- 8. The Members after carefully examining the letters and guidelines issued by the UGC from time to time (12th November 2014, 8th January 2014 and 10th April 2015) expressed their opinions as follows:-
 - The UGC in its first letter dt. 12.11.2014 issued Guidelines for the adoption of CBCS uniformly throughout the country with a Draft Template classifying the courses as Core, Elective and Foundation with a minimum 50% of Core Component while providing a Scheme for the Grading System of Evaluation in a Semester Pattern.
 - The UGC in its subsequent letter dt. 08.01.2015 based on the consensus emerged from State Education Ministers meet convened by MHRD on 06.01.2015 requested to initiate action on CBCS by addressing the following pertinent issues in order to expedite the implementation process:-

Semesterization of Curricula.

Restructuring of Syllabi in the form of Modules

Standardisation of Examination and

. Switching over from Numerical Marking System to Grade System

The UGC in its latest letter dt. 10.04.2015 directed the academic fraternity and students to send comments/feedback within 15 days for the Draft Model Syllabi proposed for Under Graduate Courses under CBCS.

4. Further, the Members on the directions of the State Government deliberated on the feasibility and implementation of CBCS and also discussed whether to commence it in a phased manner or to implement in toto in one go.

- Therefore, based on the above, you are requested to implement the CBCS (Choice Based Credit System) and NSQF (National Skills Qualification Framework) at the earliest in the academic year 2015-16 in your University...
- You are also requested to inform the Government about the progress in this regard from time to time.
