In our college we are growing medicinal plants such as Imperita cylindrica (dharba gaddi in telugu), Terminalia arjuna (thella maddhi), Coleus Amboincus (vaama aku), Rauwolfia serpentine (sarpa gandha), Sauropus androgynus, Coleus forskohli (pashana bhedi), gymnema sylvestre (poda pathri), Clitora ternatea (shankha pushpha), Vitex negundo (vaavili), Bryphyllum tinnatum (ranapala), Bacopa monnieri (neeti brahmi), Withania somnifera (ashwadandha), Terminalia chebula (karakkaya), Andrographis paniculata (neela vemu), Phyllanthus emblica (usiri), Plumbago zeylanica (chitra mulum) etc.
